Action Taken Report

(For the feedback received from stakeholders)

- D. A. V. College, Abohar adheres to the syllabi designed by Panjab University, Chandigarh. Any discrepancy whatsoever is communicated to the University through Board of Studies. A meeting of Board of Studies (BOS) is held periodically to discuss such issues.
- In 2021-22 feedback regarding syllabus and curriculum is received from 544 students, 51 teachers and 30 Alumni.
- According to students' feedback, the use of ICT tools needs to be enhanced for better understanding of the curriculum.
- In view of both students and teachers, the syllabi of some courses do not include sufficient
 practical applications of the subject which might serve as a bottle neck in grabbing the job
 opportunities.
- Some of the alumni members suggested that college should plan more field visits for students
 which can help them to gain more practical / individual experience and same should be a part
 of curriculum designed by P.U., Chandigarh.
- Students, teachers as well as alumni strongly agree that semester system is not effective for the all round development of students.
- After receiving the feedback from different stakeholders, Principal assured to take up these issues to higher authorities for appropriate solution. Panjab University did not formulate Board of Studies in the session 2021-22. So, whenever PU formulates BOS and conducts meeting, the above feedback will be conveyed to the members.
